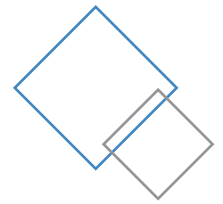

Repair and refurbishment works to leisure centre swimming pool

Having been built over 14 years ago, the pool had developed a number of leaks around the edge of the pool which were in need of repair. Francis Construction were contracted to carry out the repairs and refurbishment. Works comprised the removal and replacement of the edge tiles around the pool and a full re-tiling of the main and learner pool tanks.

Extensive concrete repair works were required to the pool and balancing tanks with restricted access to the undercroft. There were a number of steel columns that had severe rust which had to be prepared and repairs carried out with carb on wraps following shot blasting. In addition, we refurbished the shower areas and toilet facilities with a visually aesthetic solution.

Whilst these works were taking place, we also brought the changing facilities for the disabled up to date and modernised the shower areas. These works included an adjustable changing table, hoist, a Doc M WC and shower suite.

The scheme was successfully delivered on time and to budget.
