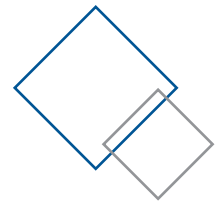

## Case Study

**Client:** Vale of White Horse

**Form of Contract:** JCT Design & Build

**Duration:** 32 weeks

**Value:** £1.2m

Works comprised the refurbishment of changing area and a large extension to the gymnasium to provide modern facilities and nearly doubled the size of the gymnasium, facilitating business growth and providing a state of the art facility. The brief was to construct a contemporary glazed curved design extension to the existing gymnasium. The concept of the design enhanced the existing curved façade of the sports centre and provide a new gymnasium space giving a higher ceiling and more space for new equipment whilst maximising energy efficiency.

The superstructure was made up of a single storey steel frame with a glass facade and a distinctive Reglit structural glazed wall. As part of the project, ground water attenuation was installed to help with the flood prevention, and a Bauder green roof was installed to limit the run off of water enhancing the scheme's green credentials.
