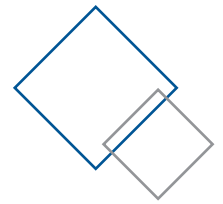


Fir Tree Primary School, Newbury

Case Study

New ASD unit and refurbishment.

This project comprised the refurbishment and extension of the existing Fir Tree Primary School including associated external works.

The project was phased allowing the school to operate with minimal disruption during term time. All sectional completion dates were met. Care was taken to communicate clearly with the schools management team to ensure smooth running of the school and the construction project.

A detailed access road closure was installed to provide segregated access to the sloping site.

The traditional superstructure and warm roof was installed. The internal fit out included windcatchers and a detailed acoustic solution as well as refurbishment and remodelling of the adjoining teaching and circulation space.
